Q Do I need to pay to enter?

A No. Entry is free, but if you want to keep your own work and do not wish to make it available for sale, a £10 donation is requested.

Q How do I enter?

A Please deliver your artwork to St Helens Primary School during the week of **10th-14th February 2020**, along with the completed form overleaf.

Q When and where will the work be displayed?

A The school will host an exhibition on **Friday 28th and Saturday 29th February 2020**.

Q What's in it for the community of St Helens?

A We will be photographing all the entries to produce an artwork documenting St Helens in 2020, for permanent display in the village.

We are looking for frames for the children's pictures: if you have any new or used A4, 10"x8", or similar-sized frames that you can spare, please bring them to the school.

FAQs

Q Who can take part in 2020 Vision: St Helens' Community Art Project?

A Anyone, from age 1 to 101, who lives, works, goes to school in, or has any other connection to St Helens, past or present. In other words: **you!** We are inviting entries from businesses, village organisations and individuals.

Q What is the theme?

A The theme is **My St Helens**, which you can interpret in any way you like.

Q What medium can I use?

A Any. You can paint, draw, embroider, knit, print, photograph, sculpt – whatever you like.

Q Are there any size specifications?

A All the children at the school will all be producing an A4 piece of work, so most works will probably be around that size, but other sizes are acceptable.

Q Do works need to be framed?

A All work needs to be durable and suitable for sale, so we ask that works on paper etc be framed (all the children's work will be framed), but if you are working on canvas or board or in more durable materials (embroidery, knitting, ceramics etc) framing isn't necessary.
